ROLE DESCRIPTION

Position Title: 0.8FTE Humanities Teacher
Position Reports to: Head of High School, and ultimately to the Head of School.
Role Location: Lorien Novalis School for Rudolf Steiner Education, Dural.

- All Staff, whole school community (staff, parents, students, interested and active parties)

About the position

The position includes active involvement in extra-curricular activities, and the position has the potential to include Class Guardianship. The teaching role includes:

- History (Stages 4 & 5)
- English (Stages 4, 5 & 6)
- Philosophy (Stage 6)

The position involves both Main Lessons, as well as Middle and Afternoon Lessons, and would include some practical lessons.

The position is for Monday to Thursday.

The position to commence February 2021.

- Accreditation to teach with the New South Wales Educational Standards Association (NESA).
- Subject specific qualifications to teach History plus one or more of the subjects as listed under "About the Position".
- Current Working with Children Check

Selection Criteria

When addressing the Selection Criteria, be concise, with a maximum overall of 2-pages.

1. An interest and/or experience in Rudolf Steiner education. Commitment to on-going study and/or professional development in regards to anthroposophy.
2. A love for working with high school students
3. The ability to follow lesson outlines to deliver engaging and developmentally appropriate curriculum for students in mixed-ability classrooms;
4. A genuine enthusiasm for teaching humanities to high school;
5. An ability to work collegially and a commitment to extra-curricular activities such as staff meetings, staff development activities, Spring Fair, Open Day, Major Works presentations, and class trips; and
6. Excellent organisational skills; as well as the ability to follow procedures; as well as excellent computer skills and the ability to use (or the ability to efficiently learn how to use) Program Builder, Edumate and Microsoft Teams;
7. Briefly list any artistic, craft, sporting, technical or other skills or interests.
